Henderson Trucking Specifies RollTek 120 Freightliner Trucks

Westfield, Ind. – May 16, 2008 – Henderson Trucking, a provider of refrigerated food shipping services based in Salem, Illinois, has specified LifeGuard RollTek® on 120 Freightliner Cascadia trucks being delivered over the course of the next six months.

Company president John Kaburick emphasized the company's reasons for ordering trucks with RollTek side roll protection. "We always look at opportunities to improve fleet safety. In March, one of our drivers had a rollover accident on an exit ramp, and he was injured," he explained. "It wasn't a major injury, but clearly if we can cut down on any injuries that could happen in the event of a rollover, it would be a worthwhile investment."

Henderson Trucking runs 500 refrigerated trailers supplying grocery stores and food distribution centers throughout the Midwest. The company employs approximately 600 drivers.

LifeGuard RollTek combines side airbag protection with the latest advancements in seatbelt technology. In a rollover, RollTek deploys within a quarter second to minimize driver movement, increase survivable space and cushion head and neck impact, significantly reducing the potential for death or serious injury.

The Cascadia by Freightliner is the first over-the-road truck that is available with LifeGuard RollTek. RollTek is also available on Oshkosh S-Series front discharge mixers, and the majority of manufacturers of custom fire apparatus now offer RollTek side roll protection.
